AN ORDER LEVYING TAXES FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE UPPER BRUSHY CREEK WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF THE UPPER BRUSHY CREEK WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT:


I.

That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the maintenance and operation of the UPPER BRUSHY CREEK WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, for the tax year 2011, upon all property within the corporate limits of said District subject to taxation, real, personal and mixed, a tax of two cents (\$0.02) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL RAISE TAXES (FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS) ON A \$185,714 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$0.15.

The Board hereby finds and declares that written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of the meeting at which this Order was adopted was posted and that such meeting was open to the public as required by law at all times during which this Order and the subject matter hereof were discussed, considered, and formally acted upon, all as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, as amended.

If taxes on the average residence homestead increase by more than eight percent, the qualified voters of the district by petition may require that an election be held to determine whether to reduce the operation and maintenance tax rate to the rollback tax rate under Section 49.236(d), Water Code.
